**W**hen Live Oak Clinic opened 9 years ago, one of the most challenging volunteer tasks was “the computers”. Now everyone in the clinic uses computers and the people we originally called “the computer volunteers” do so much more.

Our group is critical to the flow of a clinic evening, functioning much as the office staff does in your doctor’s office. We greet patients, check their contact information, make appointments, receive and send faxes, order lab tests, collect payments, and make sure patients leave with a positive feeling and know what they need to do before their next clinic visit.

We also collect data such as volunteer hours, patient visits, demographics, services provided, labs orders, and referrals. This data is used many ways, for instance to plan scheduling of medical providers and for grant applications.

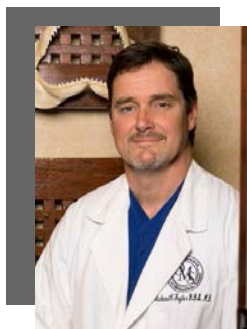
Through volunteering at Live Oak Clinic, we have become good friends and look forward to taking our turn at "the computers".
